Andrew Lansley's Health and Social Care Bill threatens to break up our health service and hand it to private healthcare companies.

The Bill would open up the entire health service to the private sector. As private companies calculate how much profit is to be made, 50000 NHS jobs are being cut. Front line staff at Royal Free Hospital, in Mental Health and the Ambulance service are under threat.

The government has now been forced to retreat in the face of a huge groundswell of nationwide opposition. Cameron and Clegg had to intervene to say they want to "pause, listen, reflect and improve" the plans, but it is clear they would like to limit the debate to minor cosmetic changes.

We have to seize this opportunity to step up public opposition to demand the Bill is dropped and to force the government to really listen. Our NHS is precious and these plans will destroy it. We appeal to everyone to join us on 17 May and to speak out against these threats in what ever way they can.
